Objective(s):

We will: demonstrate phonological awareness by using letter-sound relationships to decode text (2Bii; 2F, 4A)

Weekly Activities:

HMH: Into Reading

- 1. Look at the 3 Vocabulary cards (Power Words): burrow, soil, vine Parents: 1. Say the word. 2. Explain the meaning 3. Talk about examples.
- 2. Read Word cards (sight words): home, like, many, right. Write each word in a sentence. Draw a picture to go with your sentence. Send a picture of your work to your teacher in email or SeeSaw.
- 3. The student will listen to the 2 Read Alouds for this week: *Up In The Garden and Down In The Dirt and Earthworms*
- 4. Each student is expected to complete 20 minutes daily in Reading Eggs OR iRead online.
- 5. Each student is expected to read for 20 minutes daily and log the books read on their 4th 9 weeks reading log. Leveled readers and Start Right Readers will be assigned weekly by the homeroom teacher and can be found in the students' HMH: Into Reading online portal.
- 6. Each student will continue to practice their sight words daily. Parent may move to the next list as the student is ready.
